EPA eManifest is Live!



In an ongoing effort to assist our customers with the new EPA eManifest program, World Oil Environmental Services offers the option of Consolidated Manifests as one of our services. Currently, disposal facilities fees range up to \$20 per manifest under the new eManifest program guidelines, and these fees are eligible for increase annually by the EPA. WOES offers the convenience of consolidated manifests to our eligible customers and we charge a lower fee per pick up using consolidated manifests. Customers that qualify for consolidated manifests will significantly reduce their eManifest fees. Please refer to our website <u>www.worldoilcorp.com/emanifest</u> for current eManifest fees.

Qualifications for Consolidated Manifests:

✓ Consolidated Manifest procedures allow small quantity generators (defined as generating less than 1,000 kg/month (2,200 pounds/month) to use Consolidated Manifests. Generators may exclude the amount of used oil and contents of the oil/water separator in calculating the 1,000 kg/month or 2,200 pounds/month waste generation volume.

The following waste types are available using Consolidated Manifests:

- ✓ Used Oil
- ✓ Contents of an oil/water separator
- ✓ Solids Contaminated with used oil (Oil filters, paper filters, soil)
- ✓ Brake Fluid
- ✓ Antifreeze
- ✓ Parts Cleaning Solvents, including aqueous cleaning solvents (Parts washers)
- ✓ Absorbent contaminated with waste on this list (oil, antifreeze, parts cleaning solvents, brake fluid)
- ✓ Filters from dispensing pumps for diesel and gasoline fuels

What do I need to do to participate?


